## INFORMATION SHEET

### Bathroom Cleaning and Disinfecting

November 24, 2020

1

- ✓ Gather and prepare the cleaning and disinfecting supplies you are going to use. Make sure all supplies are clean.
- ✓ Make sure you know how to safely use the products.
- ✓ Clean your hands and put on gloves.

2

- ✓ Clean and disinfect, from clean to dirty areas:
  - Thermostat, wall-mounted items, dispensers
  - Support railings, ledges, and shelves
  - High-touch surfaces such as door handles and light switches
  - Plumbing under the sink, inside and outside of sink, sink faucet
  - Shower and tub, faucets, walls, and support railings
  - Toilet
- ✓ Clean from clean to dirty areas:
  - Walls, if soiled
  - Mirrors, windows, and glass door panels (use glasscleaner)
  - Floors

**Note: If using a bucket and cloths, do not 'double-dip' the cloths in the bucket. Change the cloth after cleaning very dirty areas.**

- ✓ If cleaning cloths were used, place them in a bag for dirty laundry.
- ✓ Place waste in the garbage and remove garbage bag if full.
- ✓ Clean garbage holder if dirty and add a clean garbage bag.
- ✓ Take off gloves and throw them into the garbage.
- ✓ Clean your hands.
