The Sioux Lookout First Nations Health Authority (SLFNHA) offers and coordinates operational supports to help communities prepare for the prevention and management of COVID-19. Many communities have reached out to us and found these supports helpful. Below is a breakdown of supports you may find helpful:

1. PPE (gloves, masks, gowns, etc.) and Cleaning Training
 - We have PowerPoint presentations and videos to train your staff to properly put on and take of PPE, as well as disinfecting surfaces and environment.
 - We can also provide virtual or in-person training for your community.
2. Pandemic Plan Review
 - We can review and provide input to strengthen your pandemic plan.
3. Emergency Operations
 - We help you set up a structure/team to respond to incidences such as a COVID-19 outbreak and other incidences.
 - The team consists of operation, communications, planning, finance, logistics, etc.
 - We can also walk through an action plan checklist for different scenarios (e.g. no cases, community spread of cases) to help prepare/adjust the response based on risk
 - We can also guide discussions on easing restrictions within communities
 - We can connect you to the Finance/Admin team to support in writing possible COVID-19 related funding proposals
4. Alternate care sites (assessment, isolation, quarantine)
 - can review designed floor plans and provide recommendations/ suggestions
 - can write draft floor plans and review with community
 - we can also visit the community to inspect and help set up these sites.
5. Connect you with food safety training, security training, and personal support worker training

All these services can be delivered virtually/remote or in person. SLFNHA has a travel protocol in place for staff to ensure they do not present any risks to the community. More details about the travel protocol can be provided upon request.
